HOW TO APPLY:

1. Complete the application and submit it to the Extension Wood County office by 1 May 2021.
2. *Youth* applicants, **MUST** submit **BOTH** of the following with their application:
 - a. Letter of recommendation from a club *or* project leader (*not a parent*).
 - b. Letter from a parent/guardian, indicating acceptance of their supporting role (transportation, internet access, etc.)
3. Applicants will be scheduled for interviews in **early to mid-May**. Dates, times, & method will be announced as soon as possible.
