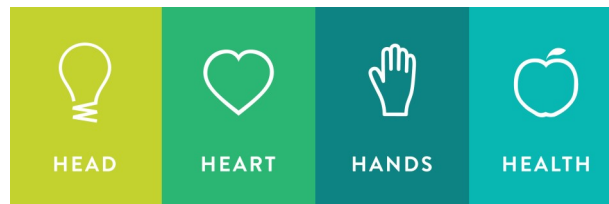


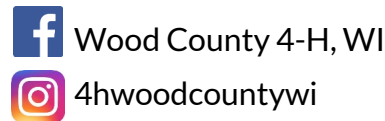
WHAT IS 4-H?

- ◆ The 4-H program begins at the club level. Our 4-H members, parents and leaders meet monthly to have fun, learn and work together in project groups, club activities, special interest groups, and many events.
- ◆ 4-H belongs to the members, their families, and other interested adults who serve as volunteer leaders. Leadership is provided by the University of Wisconsin-Madison Division of Extension. The 4-H program is a joint effort of county government, University of Wisconsin, and the United States Department of Agriculture.
- ◆ 4-H is an informal educational program through which parents, other adults, and youth help young people develop confidence, social skills, decision-making abilities, and subject matter knowledge in a variety of project areas.
- ◆ 4-H and University of Wisconsin-Madison Division of Extension provide affirmative action and equal opportunity in education, programming and employment for all qualified persons regardless of race, color, gender/sex, creed, disability, religion, national origin, ancestry, age, sexual orientation, pregnancy, marital or parental, arrest or conviction record or veteran status.
