HOW TO APPLY:

- 1. Complete the application and submit it to the Extension Wood County office by October 31st, 2022.
- 2. Youth applicants, MUST submit BOTH of the following with their application:
 - a. Letter of recommendation from a club or project leader (not a parent).
 - b. Letter from a parent/guardian, indicating acceptance of their supporting role (transportation, internet access, etc.)
- 3. Applicants will be scheduled for interviews in *early to mid-November*. Dates, times, & method will be announced as soon as possible.
