### 2023 SUMMER YOUTH QUILT CAMP

What:	All participants will be making a Hopscotch throw-sized quilt.		

The completed quilt contains 17 black blocks and 18 white blocks plus borders.

Participants will need to purchase fabric and thread for the top and backing. Several different fabrics will be needed for the quilt top:

Whites: 1/6 yd of each of six different white fabrics \*

- Blacks: 1/4 yd of each of five different black fabrics \*
  - 5/8 yd border fabric
  - 1/2 yd binding fabric

Brights: 1/6 yd of each of five different bright fabrics (Fat quarters may be used.)

Plus 3 ½ yds for backing fabric

Check the internet for JoAnn's coupons.

\* It never hurts to purchase and extra 1/8 to 1/4 yd to allow for mishaps.

After registering, letters will be sent with more information. Piecemakers Quilt Guild will supply cutting equipment and provide assistance in cutting and sewing of the quilt. The guild will also provide each quilter who completes their top on time, batting and machine quilting of the finished top.

Camp is limited to 10 participants, with a minimum of 5 participants. Spaces fill up quickly. Please check the dates as there will be no makeup dates.

Quilters are encouraged to bring their own sewing machines. A limited number of machines will be available. Registration deadline is May 10. Please mail registrations to: Dawn Hasz

# YMHFA TRAINING

Adult volunteers who plan to chaperone overnight trips or experiences, are required to complete the Youth Mental Health First Aid Training.

While this is a great training for everyone and we encourage our volunteers to take it as they are able, it is **REQUIRED** if you plan to be a chaperone.

This class is offered at a variety of times. If you anticipate acting as a chaperone for camp or other overnight activities, we encourage you to complete this training now so you are ready!



#### LEARN HOW TO SUPPORT THE YOUNG PEOPLE IN YOUR LIFE

Youth Mental Health First Aid teaches you how to identify, understand and respond to signs of mental health and substance use challenges among adolescents ages 12-18. You'll build skills and confidence you need to reach out and provide initial support to young people who are struggling. You'll also learn how to help connect them to appropriate support.

#### AFTER THE COURSE, YOU'LL BE ABLE TO:

- Recognize common signs and symptoms of mental health challenges, including anxiety, depression, eating disorders and attention deficit hyperactive disorder (ADHD).
- Recognize common signs and symptoms of substance use challenges.
- Understand how to interact with a young person in crisis.
- Know how to connect a young person with help.
- Better understand trauma, substance use, self-care and the impact of social media and bullying
