Spring is nearly here - the season of little chicks and bunnies, right?

In Wood County 4-H it really is the season of chicks! We just wrapped up our first ChickQuest program and it was incredible! ChickQuest is a 4-H curriculum designed for classrooms. Over the course of 4-6 weeks, 4-H staff work with students to explore

chicken life cycles and the ag industry. They use science, technology, engineering, and math skills to investigate the life cycle of an embryonic chicken egg. Students track environmental data daily and track embryo development weekly.



For our first-ever ChickQuest program, 6 of the original 12 eggs successfully hatched! The students and staff were so egg-cited on hatching day that it was a little hard to concentrate on the day's regular curriculum. Who can blame them? How often do youth get to watch the miracle of hatching?

Congratulations to Hunter O. of Kountry Kids 4-H club. He is the lucky 4-H'er to add these chicks to his flock.



- Youth must graduate a WI DNR Hunter Education Course to participate. Proof of completion required. Find classes now!
- Youth are encouraged to bring their own shotgun, and guns will be available for use if needed
- Gauges 12 and smaller can be used.
- The CW4HSS shotgun program will have 12 and 20 gauge ammo available. You supply your own ammo for all other gauges.
- Only Shot sizes 7 ½ to 9 are allowed.
- Heavy magnum loads are NOT allowed.
- Loads with a maximum speed of 1290 FPS are allowed.


