

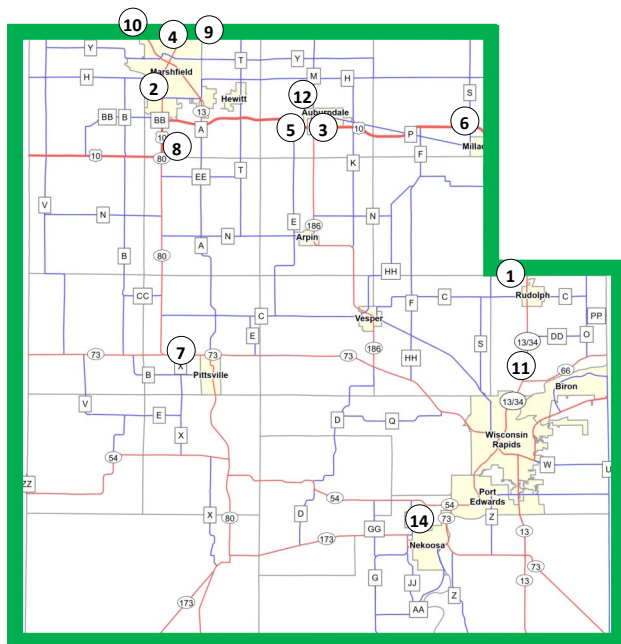
WHAT IS 4-H?

Wood County 4-H Club Locations

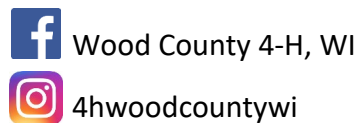
