


SHOOTING SPORTS ORIENTATION

SUNDAY, DECEMBER 7 | CENTRAL WISCONSIN SPORTSMANS CLUB, MARSHFIELD | 12:00PM

Have you tried shooting sports? This program is open to youth in 3rd grade (and at least 8 years old) and up. There are many disciplines to choose from ranging from archery to air pistol and air rifle, as well as the summer shotgun program.

The Central Wisconsin 4-H Shooting Sports program is a great program for youth to gain important life skills such as self-discipline, decision-making, problem-solving and self-confidence. If you are new or returning, this program may be just what you want. When you enroll in 4-H, be sure to select the appropriate Shooting Sports project that you will be participating in, as the projects are separated by discipline (Shooting Sports – Archery, Shooting Sports – Air Rifle, etc.). This will ensure that you are included in all future communications for the program.





- The open house starts at Noon, which allows new and returning members to check out the equipment and talk with instructors and get any questions answered that you may have.
- We will have a beginner orientation at 12:45 which is mandatory for all new members. This will give you a more in-depth look at the program. Sign-up will start at 1pm. We will ask all youth and adults to sign the rules and acknowledge them as read. Those that attend the 1pm sign-up will have first choice for line times.



New this year! We will have Glen's Sport Shop on site to do bow inspections. If you have archery equipment that needs to be inspected, we will have forms on hand and the cost will be \$5.

We will also have the bow rental program running, which allows youth the opportunity to rent the equipment for the season, and not only use it at practice but also practice at home and/or attend other shoots/tournaments put on by other counties. There will be NO new registrations or rentals after the 2nd practice.


WOOD COUNTY SERVICE PROJECT
