### **ENROLL NOW FOR THE NEW 4H YEAR!**

Welcome to the new 4-H year! Enrollment for this year opened in 4HOnline in September and many of you have already re-enrolled.

For those who still need to complete the process, here are a few helpful tips:

The project listing in 4-H Online has been simplified and Wisconsin 4-H has published a new Project Guide to help you navigate the new system.

- 1. Projects have been broken into 7 project groups that are easier to related to fair departments.
- 2. The guide includes descriptions of each project area along with examples of how youth can grow in the project area.
- 3. Cloverbud remains the only project available for youth in K-2nd grade. It is under the "Leadership & Community" project group.
- 4. Exploring (for all 3rd graders) is also found under "Leadership & Community." In Wood County, Exploring is the project to select for 3rd graders, not for all first-year members as the guide describes.
  - All 3rd graders should enroll in Exploring.
  - 3rd graders interested in animal/livestock projects and shooting sports should also enroll in those projects to assist in communication.

4HOnline is the enrollment software we use. It is easiest to use on a laptop, but will work on a tablet or mobile phone. Before you start the enrollment process, please check out our Family Enrollment Guide for step by step pictures to get you through.

Youth and adult volunteer re-enrollments are due by November 1st. Members who have not enrolled by this date will no longer receive program communications from our office.

### WISCONSIN 4-H KEY AWARD

Did you know that the Wisconsin 4-H Key Award is the highest honor a 4-H'er can earn in the state? Youth who receive this honor are those who have demonstrated consistent growth in 4-H involvement, developed and applied their leadership skills, and have actively participated in 4-H functions in their club and community.

To be eligible for this award youth must:

- be in grades 11-13
- been a 4-H member for at least 3 years
- completed at least one year of youth leadership

Evaluation of applicants will be based on:

- Membership / Club Experience
- Projects
- Activities

- Leadership
- Personal Development
- County 4-H and Community Involvement

This award is sponsored by the Wisconsin Farm Bureau Federation and Rural Mutual Insurance Company.

To be considered for this award, youth must submit this application by Wednesday, October 15.

### WOOD COUNTY CLOVERBUD PROGRAM


#### Join us for the 2025-26 Wood County Cloverbud Program!

### MEMBER AWARDS AND PORTFOLIOS

#### MEMBER AWARDS

There are many types of awards available to members. Some are presented at the November Recognition and others are given to the clubs to award. The applications for all of the county awards can be found here.

**Bronze, Silver, Gold, or Honor Record Awards** are given to each member who has completed the 4-H Member Permanent Records form. Awards are based on the number of points earned and submitted o a member's permanent record.

**Project Awards** are given to members who have learned a great deal and done outstanding work in their projects. Each member can apply for no more than 3 project awards. For each project a member is applying for, a separate Project Award Application must be filled out. Members may choose to have their Project Story from their Portfolio considered for a Project Award instead of filling out a separate form.

**Activity Awards** are awarded in 4 areas: Leadership, Achievement, Community Service and Public Speaking & Demonstration.

**Officer Awards** are given to 3 club secretaries and 3 club treasurers who submit their completed officer books. Awards are given based on neatness, legibility and completeness of the book.

#### **PORTFOLIOS**

Wood County 4-H members in grades 3 and higher are encouraged to complete a portfolio every year they are in 4-H. A portfolio documents what you have learned and accomplished in 4-H. It encourages you to keep a record of your 4-H work, and helps you set goals throughout your 4-H experience.

A portfolio also shows your growth over time. It is designed to be a great source of information that you will be able to use to complete scholarship, job, and college entrance applications. Additionally, it is fun to have a record of your 4-H experiences over the years!

Members can start a portfolio at any point in their 4-H experience, or continue building a portfolio after missing a few years. Members submitting portfolios can also earn awards.

For award consideration, portfolios must be signed by your club's General Leader and submitted to the Extension Office or a member of the Leaders Association Executive Board (Stacy Musch, Jodie Budtke or Laura Strigel) by October 27th—no late entries accepted.
