




YQCA TRAINING

LIVESTOCK SKILLATHON AND QUIZ BOWL

MARCH 21 | UW-MADISON CAMPUS

Livestock Bowl is a quiz competition where all the questions are about beef, sheep, swine, and meat goat topics and students use a buzzer in order to answer the questions. Teams compete in a double elimination format by giving oral answers to questions posed by a moderator. Each match has both an individual and toss-up question round. The winning 4-H senior team will represent Wisconsin at the National 4-H Livestock Quiz Bowl competition held each fall in Louisville at the **North American International Livestock Exposition (NAILE)**.

Skillathon contest is made up of a written quiz and learning stations such as breed identification, feed identification, equipment identification as well as some team activities such as demonstrating evaluation skills. The top Senior level 4-H team will represent Wisconsin at the National 4-H Skillathon Contest, held each fall in Louisville at the **North American International Livestock Exposition (NAILE)**.

Competition in Quiz Bowl & Skillathon encourages members to develop a more complete knowledge of animals and related subjects. This contest provides an educational program for all project members, including those who may not own a project animal, and provides a way to develop self-confidence. These programs are a great parallel to some similar programs that breed associations and other organizations conduct.

Who can participate? Any current 4-H members grades 3-13. Please note, there are age divisions for each of those contests and parameters for grade 13 members. Cloverbud project members are not eligible to participate in this experience. Even if your county has not participated in the past, round-up some 4-H friends and take advantage of this fun opportunity to show your knowledge of the animal species and industry.



DOG QUIZ BOWL COMPETITION

Mark your calendars for the upcoming 4-H Dog Bowl Contest on Saturday, April 25, 2026 at UW Green Bay in the STEM Innovation Building!

We hope you join us for a day full of fun, learning and competition!

WHAT IS DOG QUIZ BOWL?

Competition in the 4-H Dog Bowl encourages youth to develop a more complete knowledge of dogs and related subjects. This contest provides an educational program for all dog project members, including those who may not own a dog, and provides a way to develop self-confidence, study skills, teamwork, inhibition, and alertness.

The Dog Bowl is a “quiz bowl” competition where all questions deal with dog-related topics and attitudes of friendliness and fairness prevail. Teams of three to four members compete with each other in giving oral answers to questions posed by a moderator. Teams receive points for correct answers and may lose points for incorrect answers. The team with the highest final score is the winner.

The contest is organized on a bracket elimination style contest with winning teams advancing into further rounds until a champion team emerges.

TEAM REGISTRATION FEE: There is a \$15.00 entry fee per team with payment due by the day of the event.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: March 30th, in 4HOnline.

PARTICIPATION: All participants need to be currently enrolled WI 4-H members. Teams are divided into three age divisions, and teams can consist of 3 or 4 members. More information about age divisions is available in the The WI 4-H Dog Bowl Information Packet linked below.

Each photo will be judged by a group of skilled photographers. **The top photo in each category will be printed, mounted and displayed at the State 4-H office, be a part of the 4-H State Art show at Summer Academy, shared on the Wisconsin 4-H social media sites and available for display at other statewide events.** Each category winner will be eligible for recognition for the overall best photo. Top photos will be used to promote the 2027 contest.

The top overall photos from the entire contest will receive \$100 for first place, \$75 for second place, and \$50 for third place.
